### Cub Scout Packs - Program Sec. Req.

#### #6 - Conduct outdoor activities and field trips.

- Bronze Level - 50 Pts.: Each den participates in 3 outdoor activities or field trips during the year.
- Silver Level - 100 Pts.: Each den participates in 4 outdoor activities or field trips during the year.
- Gold Level - 200 Pts.: Each den participates in 5 outdoor activities or field trips during the year.

#### #7 - Cub Scouts attend Day Camp, and/or Resident Camp.

- Bronze Level - 50 Pts.: 33% of Cubs participates in camping experience or improve over prior year.
- Silver Level - 100 Pts.: 50%, or 33% and have improvement over the prior year.
- Gold Level - 200 Pts.: 75%, or 50% and have improvement over the prior year.



### Boy Scout Troops - Program Sec. Req.

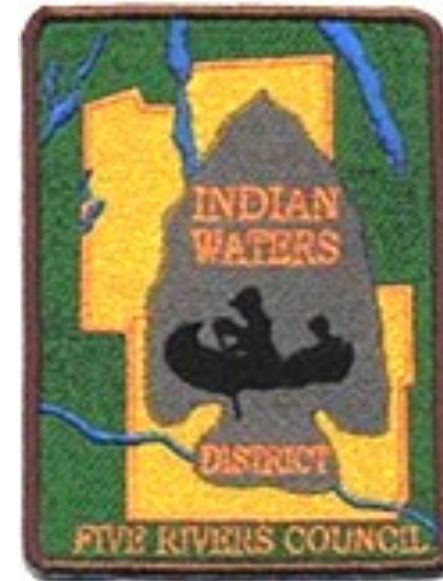
#### #6 - Conduct short-term/wknd. campouts throughout the year.

- Bronze Level - 50 Points: Conduct 4 short-term overnight campouts.
- Silver Level - 100 Pts.: Conduct 7 short-term overnight campouts.
- Gold Level - 200 Pts.: Conduct 9 short-term overnight campouts.

#### #7 - Participate in long-term camp w/troop majority attending.

- Bronze Level - 50 Pts.: The troop participates in a long-term camp.
- Silver Level - 100 Pts.: 60% of Scouts attend a long-term camp.
- Gold Level - 200 Pts.: 70% of Scouts attend a long-term camp.

Earn the Den Streamer for having 50% or more of Cub Scout Den members participate in each Pack activity in June, July and August.



Earn the Summertime Pack Award Pin for Tiger, Wolf, Bear or Webelos Scouts that participate in all 3 Pack activities in June, July and August.

Bear - Complete Bear Necessities Adv. & 6 Outdoor Activities.

Webelos - Complete Walkabout Adv. & 7 Outdoor Activities.

## National Outdoor Challenge Award



Earn the Troop Unit Streamer by achieving the following:

1. Have a written Troop annual plan.
2. Conduct 10 outdoor activities w/ 50% Scouts participating. or Increase number of outdoor activities over previous year.
3. Attend summer camp or Hi-Adventure experience.
4. Conduct 1 outing with a Webelos Scout Den.
5. Earn 1 outdoor related Merit Badge per registered Scout.
6. Conduct 1 LNT program with 50%+ of registered Scouts.
