Winter Course-Camp Gorton February 17-19 & March 2-4 Summer Course-Camp Brulé Summer-2018

Dear Unit Leader,

National Youth Leadership Training (NYLT) is an intense six-day training course for Scouts, Venturers, Sea Scouts, and Explorers that lives the month in the life of a Troop. This course provides Scouts with the leadership skills they need to be truly effective. It is the most advanced youth leader training that Five Rivers Council offers and features instruction and hands on experiences in Leading Themselves, Leading Others, Making Moral and Ethical Decisions, and learn the BE-KNOW-DO of being a leader. A trained staff of youth leaders and instructors work closely with qualified adult mentors to conduct this course. Participants and their training "patrols" get an opportunity to practice and experience state of the art leadership skills for highly effective teams—firsthand!

Unit Leaders select and nominate the Scouts who may attend NYLT, sending those who currently or will soon hold key leadership positions in the Troop. Scouts attending must be at least 13 years old by the first day of the course and have obtained the rank of First Class (no exceptions) Nominees should have completed the Troop's own Introduction to Leadership Skills for Troops/Crews experience and have had at least one leadership position within the Unit. A minimum of \$60 must be sent in with the Scout's application as a deposit. If application and full fee are received by January 15, 2018 the early bird fee is \$190. After that the regular fee of \$230 takes effect.

Registration can be made online at <u>www.fiverivers.org</u> or in person at the Scout Store in the Arnot Mall.

The winter course takes place over two weekends. February 17th-19th and March 2nd-4th.

Enclosed you will find a brochure with an application. Please share this information with your youth that you would like to attend. It is highly recommended that you do not wait as this course is limited to the first 35 who register and we are expecting a full course this year.


