What is IOLS?

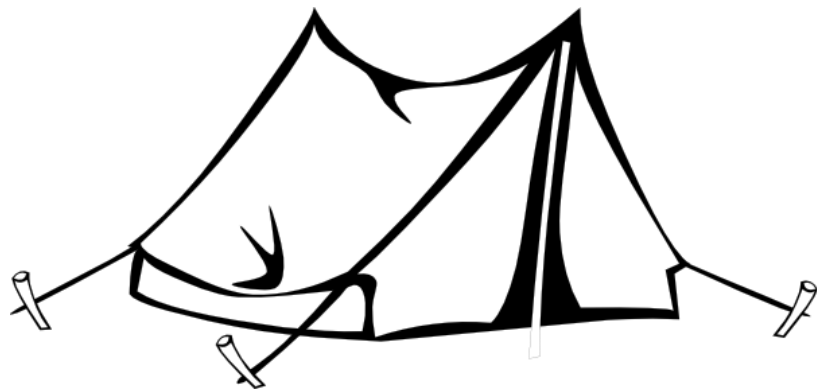

This training is a weekend-long training that is a continuum of the Scoutmaster Basics classroom training and **REQUIRED** to be a registered Scoutmaster or Assistant Scoutmaster.

Tent overnight camping is required.

- Interfaith Worship
