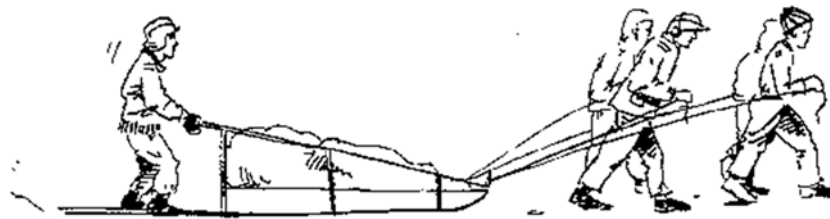

Overall use of Patrol Method

Basic Information

REGISTRATION: The Registration Fee is \$20.00 if paid by December 28, 2018. If paid after December 28, pizza Friday Night is not available and Breakfast on Saturday becomes an additional charge of \$6.00. This helps to ensure the proper number of patches and amount of food are purchased showing that scouts are THRIFTY! Only PRE-REGISTRATION GUARANTEES A PATCH!

ARRIVAL: Check in between 6:00pm – 9:00pm on Friday. On Saturday check in between 7am – 8am

WHAT TO BRING Personal & Unit Gear, Ropes for Lashing, Shelter Building Materials, Trail Cooking Materials and Supplies for Lunch, Personal First Aid Kits, Compass, Handbook, Uniform, Water Bottle, Mug / Cup for Hot Chocolate, a Sled ready for wet or dry conditions.

DRESS: Winter weather camping for outdoors. Hat and Gloves a must. NO SNEAKERS!!! Scout Uniforms for Scouts Own and Dinner.

FOOD: Pizza Friday night and Breakfast Saturday are provided. Each troop will be responsible for its food for cooking events and for unit meals for Saturday Lunch, Pot Luck Dinner, and Sunday Breakfast. Cracker Barrel during the Friday night Leaders meeting and Saturday night are provided.

CAMPSITES: Campsites are on a first come, first serve basis. As always event staff have final say in any discussion regarding the setting up of campsites, campfire rings, ground cloths and hay.

TRASH: As always, a scout is clean. This also pertains to the camp. What you bring in, you take out with you. Let's leave it clean for the spring events!

SAFETY: Knives, axes, and saws used by units shall be the responsibility of the unit leader. Any unsafe or improper use shall result in the lowering of the patrol score. Anyone using an ax, saw, or knife must have a valid Totin' Chip card. No sheath knives or machetes are to be used. Any incidents using any equipment should be reported to the First Aid station.

VISITORS: Visitors are invited to attend but cannot participate in the events. If you are inviting families to attend, please make them aware of the winter weather at Camp Brulé so they are prepared for the snow and/or cold.

COMPETITIVE EVENTS: Round Robin Challenge Events around the camp. Participants visit stations and challenge their skills based on the station.

AWARDS: Each unit participating will receive a participation ribbon. 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place ribbons will be awarded to the winning patrols of each competitive event.

SATURDAY DINNER: The Saturday night dinner is a pot luck dinner with dish to pass in the dining hall. Plates, Cups, and Silverware are provided. Show off your unit's cooking skills.
