The Columbia-Montour Council will hold its sixth College of Commissioner Science training course. This is similar to last year's college and will offer courses toward all 3 degrees. The College will run from 7:45 am until 4:35 pm.

A Bachelor's Degree requires 7 courses (at least 5 BCS courses). A Master's Degree requires 14 total courses (at least 7 MCS courses). A Doctor's Degree requires 24 total courses (at least 5 DCS courses). There are additional requirements for the Master's and Doctor's degrees, but are not prerequisites (Arrowhead Honor and Commissioner's Key + thesis respectively).

The College will be held at the Lighthouse in Lightstreet, PA (just off I-80 exit 236). There will be a \$7.00 fee to cover certificates. Bring your bag lunch and any record sheets from previous classes. Preregistration is requested by Friday, March 15, 2019.
